SAFETY HIGHLIGHTS

Award Winning Safety Practices

At Cameron LNG, safety is a core value of our organization. We continuously review and implement best practices that not only promote safe behaviors, but that engage our employees in contributing to a culture that maximizes safety and well-being. Additionally, in preparation for potential events that could disrupt business operations or impact our employees, customers, vendors and communities, we also have developed robust emergency response and business continuity plans.

Key safety initiatives and milestones achieved in 2021 included:

- Recognition for safety in the workplace
 - In 2021, Cameron LNG was recognized by the National Safety Council for working nearly 90 million man-hours with zero lost-time incidents during construction of the terminal and the transition to operations
- Extensive safety training with employees
 - 129 employees completing 1,352 hours of Emergency Response training
 - 78 employees achieving 380 hours of Maintenance training
- Enhancement and implementation of the Cameron LNG Emergency Response Plan
 - Conducting annual emergency response drills at both Cameron and with local and regional Emergency Response teams in Cameron and Calcasieu Parishes
- Enhancement and implementation of the Cameron LNG Hurricane Preparedness Plan
 - Meetings with local Emergency Management and Waterway partners to share and coordinate hurricane preparedness measures
 - Monitoring of the Calcasieu Channel with the USCG, Port of Lake Charles and Pilots to optimize safe navigation
- Enhancement and implementation of the Cameron LNG COVID Mitigation Plan
 - Successful operations of the facility with no interruptions to daily operations throughout the ongoing pandemic



Cameron LNG was recognized by the National Safety Council for working 89,400,000 hours with zero lost-time incidents during construction and transition to operations.
