A partner in the community for nearly 20 years, Cameron LNG is committed to giving back and making a positive difference in the communities where we live and work.

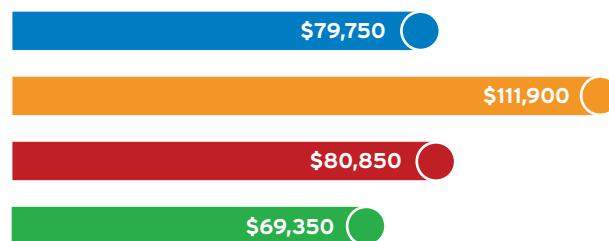

## COASTAL RESTORATION AWARD



In May 2022, the Coalition to Restore Coastal Louisiana (CRCL) selected Cameron LNG to receive the 2022 Hurricane Laura Coastal Stewardship Award for our contributions to restoring coastal beaches, wetlands and wildlife habitats. CRCL works at the state, local and federal levels to ensure that restoring and protecting coastal Louisiana are top priorities for our state and the nation.



## Cameron LNG Employee Giving Fund



Cameron LNG's Employee Giving Fund (EGF) makes giving charitable contributions to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations quick and easy for our employees. Employees can enroll in voluntary payroll deductions and pool the money with other employee contributions to increase giving power. The Fund has distributed \$180,850 in grants to various nonprofits within the community since its inception in 2016. Nonprofit organizations are nominated by employees, and fund allocations are voted on quarterly by a committee of employees representing both our Hackberry and Houston offices.

## 2022 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP HIGHLIGHTS

### ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

Cameron LNG is committed to sustainable stewardship and environmental preservation. Through our annual community partnership program, we are proud to partner in efforts that preserve and protect wildlife habitats, wetland areas and support beautification efforts in our communities.

#### Hackberry Cemetery Earth Month Project

In recognition of Earth month, Cameron LNG partnered with the Hackberry Cemetery Association to restore the landscaping at this community landmark. Cameron LNG employees and community members planted 50 crape myrtle trees to replace pine trees destroyed by Hurricane Laura in 2020. This two-phase project will be completed in 2023 with additional tree plantings and other beautification efforts.



### EDUCATION | STEM

Our education initiatives are focused on helping to prepare future generations and grow a vibrant workforce. This is achieved by supporting programs at local schools and colleges focused on promoting learning and teacher development in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).

#### Cameron LNG Graduating Senior and Continuing Education Programs

In 2012, Cameron LNG launched a competitive scholarship program for students graduating from one of the four high schools in Cameron Parish. Four years later, the Continuing Education Scholarship program was announced, allowing previous winners to apply for funds that could be applied to their advanced education. Both programs support students pursuing degrees at educational institutions including trade schools, technical colleges, community colleges, four-year colleges or universities.



To date, more than \$140,000 has been awarded to 96 Cameron Parish graduates through our Graduating Senior Program. Additionally, awards totaling \$92,000 have helped 21 students continue to pursue their higher education goals.

### ECONOMIC PROSPERITY AND LEADERSHIP

As a company dedicated to enhancing the economic prosperity and resiliency of the region where we operate, Cameron LNG works alongside community and business leaders to invest time and resources to support local economies and help build thriving communities.

#### Port Wonder Project

Cameron LNG is proud to be one of the first LNG companies to support the City of Lake Charles' iconic new education complex featuring the Children's Museum of Lake Charles and the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries Science Center and Educational Complex (SCEC). In June, city and state officials celebrated the groundbreaking of Port Wonder, a \$20+ million lakefront development project. This economic development partnership grant will help fund STEM-based, hands-on interactive exhibits and an immersive, live-animal Louisiana coast experience.



### EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS & SAFETY

At Cameron LNG, safety is a core value of our organization and the top priority of our employees. Our relationships with law enforcement agencies and emergency responders in Cameron and Calcasieu parishes support our commitment to emergency preparedness and safety. Our Safe Communities initiative makes a significant impact on communities with partnerships focused on eradicating hunger, providing healthcare screenings and delivering other critical services to improve quality of life for all.

#### Second Harvest - South Cameron Food Pantry

Through our annual partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, we helped launch a new food pantry at South Cameron High School. Operating twice a month, this school pantry has become an important resource to students and their families. Over the course of the year, the canned-food pantry was transformed into an on-site grocery store offering meat, produce, dairy and household items and is now the closest grocery store within a 40-minute drive for residents of the Cameron community.
