With our partners, we have built a global business deeply connected to Southwest Louisiana, distributing cleaner energy across the globe.

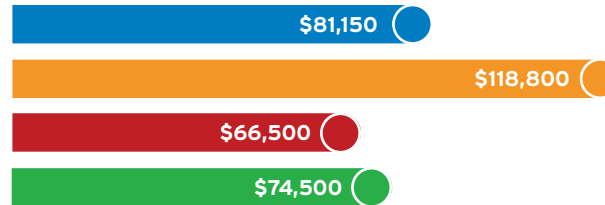
As a committed community partner for over two decades, Cameron LNG actively gives back, positively impacting the places in which we live and work.

Since 2002, we've contributed nearly \$4 million to nonprofit and business organizations, enriching the region. Aligned with our company culture and values, our community investment strategy aims to champion local growth, development, and the well-being of communities.



Cameron LNG's Employee Giving Fund (EGF) simplifies the process of charitable contributions for our employees, offering a quick and easy way to support 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations. Through voluntary payroll deductions, employees can combine their contributions, amplifying the collective impact. Since its inception in 2016, the Fund has distributed \$230,850 in grants to diverse nonprofits within the community. Employees nominate organizations, and a committee representing our Hackberry and Houston offices votes on fund allocations quarterly.

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP AND SUSTAINABILITY

Dedicated to environmental sustainability, Cameron LNG prioritizes responsible stewardship and conservation. Our annual community partnership program proudly collaborates on initiatives to preserve and protect wildlife habitats and wetland areas and promote beautification efforts within our communities.

Hackberry Trash Bash

Cameron LNG employees partnered with Sempra Infrastructure employees and local residents for a community cleanup. Employees dedicated their time and effort to making the first annual Trash Bash a success. Volunteers collected 73 bags of debris and litter from the 2.5-mile stretch along Main Street in Hackberry, Louisiana, which demonstrates our commitment to preserving the environment and making our community a better place to live.



EDUCATION (STEM)

Centered on empowering the workforce of tomorrow, our education initiatives focus on fostering vibrant, skilled individuals. We achieve this by championing programs in local schools and colleges, placing a strong emphasis on promoting learning and advancing curriculum in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) fields.

Internship program with local colleges

Cameron LNG offers a 10-week summer internship program for college students who are interested in pursuing a career within the energy sector. Through this program, interns better understand the LNG industry and the liquefaction process. Assignments mirror the responsibilities of Cameron LNG professionals, and special projects provide exposure to other critical functions of the business. The experience is both challenging and rewarding, offering valuable reinforcement to support career aspirations. We are proud to partner with McNeese State University and SOWELA Technical Community College to source qualified local individuals to fill available internship opportunities.

Leadership SWLA
